Ethics

Ethics Advisor: Tricia Kuehn (ethics@breastfeedingusa.org)

At Breastfeeding USA we take our commitment to providing volunteer peer breastfeeding support to families seriously. We have created a set of ethics that guide our organization to ensure that we are all upholding the mission of BfUSA with integrity.

Please remember to separate your role as a volunteer for BfUSA from any paid roles you may have. This can be especially tricky for those who work in women's health or provide breastfeeding related services. As an example of our expectations, when listing yourself on a website as a BfUSA BC, do not add any professional credentials or job titles after your name, or reference your business or website. If you ever have any questions about how to separate these roles, please reach out. I have attached an example for clarity.

From the Code of Ethics:

"Individuals shall not promote other causes when representing Breastfeeding USA or use Breastfeeding USA materials, resources, programs, and activities to promote other causes." "Disclose any financial or other conflicts of interest in relevant organizations providing goods or services. Ensure that judgment is not influenced by any commercial considerations."

Example 1:

Tricia leads monthly Breastfeeding USA support groups at the public library. Drop in 9:30-11:00 AM the first Monday of each month.

Example 2:

Tricia Kuehn, BC, CD(DONA), CLC, leads monthly Breastfeeding USA support groups at the public library. Drop in 9:30-11:00 AM the first Monday of each month.

Example 1 is more appropriate for a BfUSA volunteer. The second example is problematic because it is 1) more likely to cause a mom to seek out the BC's paid services than the first; 2) could create a power differential between the BC and the mom, remember we are a PEER support organization; 3) may present a conflict with whose insurance is responsible for this BC (BfUSA or her personal lactation insurance?); 4) does not use the BfUSA email for BfUSA work.

Information Technology

BfUSA has been implementing CiviCRM for the last few years to help manage our volunteer, donor, and membership information. We chose Civi because of how customizable it is; we continue to find features that help the backend run more smoothly. It is powerful for its search capabilities. It's quick and easy for our Membership Manager, Karyn, to search for expired members, sort them by expiration date, and send reminder emails. It's easier to send digital membership cards, which cuts down on hours of volunteer time. Candidate support can quickly double check when fees have been paid. Funding and Development is able to see donations come in and quickly send thank yous, and also track that the thank you was sent. Using technology in this way is a major focus of the 2018 Strategic Plan.

Funding and Development


