Breastfeeding USA is a nonprofit organization whose purpose is to provide evidence-based information and support to women and families through its national network of volunteer accredited Breastfeeding Counselors (BCs). Parents benefit greatly from the support and encouragement of other parents.

Breastfeeding is the biological norm, and we believe that the decision to breastfeed is not about lifestyle, but about the total physical and emotional health of mother and baby in the short and long term. We believe there's value in any amount of breastfeeding and human milk feeding, and we are glad to help everyone meet their personal lactation goals.

Breastfeeding USA Counselors have the freedom to choose among many ways of helping and supporting mothers. Based on what seems to be the best fit for their community, they may offer breastfeeding drop-in centers, breastfeeding cafes, classes, regular meetings, online or phone help, home visits, and more.

To qualify to become a Breastfeeding USA Counselor, you must have breastfed a baby for at least one year. The accreditation process includes instruction in best breastfeeding

practices and counseling skills through a unique, centralized, online educational program. This standardized instruction ensures that all Breastfeeding USA Counselors receive the same high-quality preparation, so they can provide consistent, effective, and empathetic breastfeeding help that respects individual differences.
